

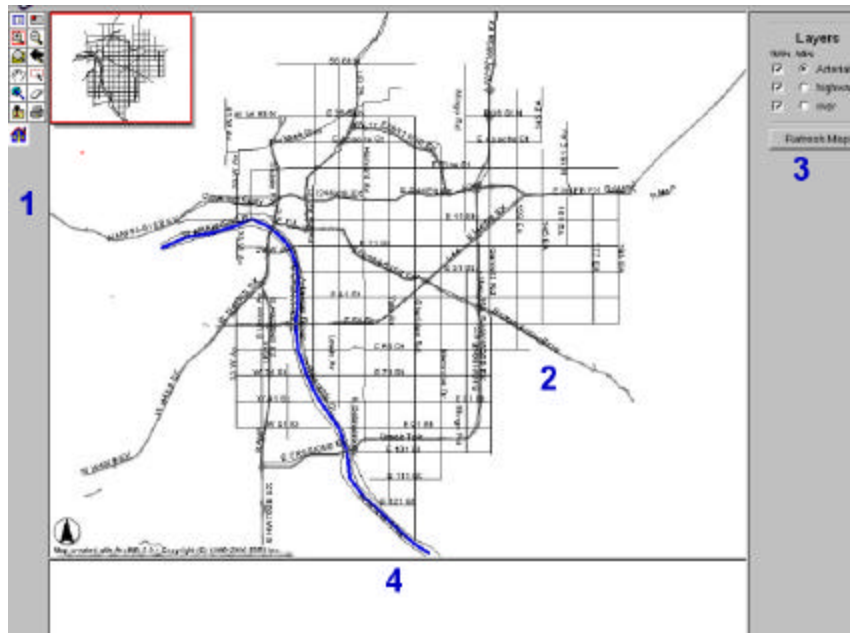

Quick Start Guide-The map will not display crime data until you are at the neighborhood level.

Seven Steps to Mapping Crime

- 1. Toolbar
- 2. Map Window
- 3. Layer/Legend
- 4. Information Frame



1. Click the locate address button in the Toolbar 

2. Type in an address in the bottom Information Frame using the following format:

The alpha characters should be in upper case (capitalized). The numeric streets should be typed as 53rd, 64th, 71st 82nd etc. Do not put street or east avenue at the end of the address. Examples:

4519 S Yukon 1050 E 61st 400 E 3rd 4100 S Yale

Layer: <input type="text" value="ttown"/>	<input type="button" value="Locate"/>
Street: street number, street name and type	<input type="text"/>
Cross street: cross street name and type	<input type="text"/>

Click on the Locate button

3. Click on the number next to the address

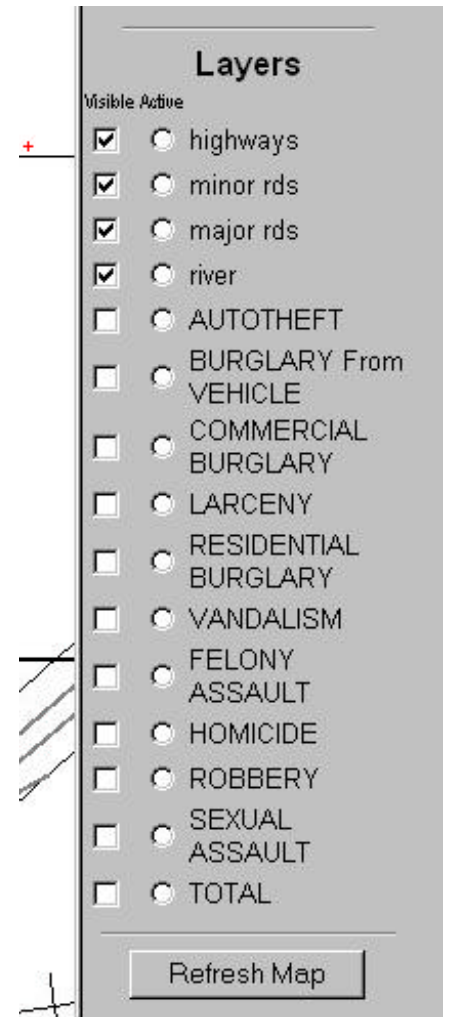
4. The map window will zoom to the neighborhood around that location and display crime options in the right Legend/Layer frame.

5. You may select any crime to display by selecting the left column. Click in the square next to as many crimes as you want to display. Clicking on the Refresh Map button will change the map display.

NOTE: Crimes at the same address or in the same general location may display dots on top of each other. Step 6 will provide information on each crime.



Click on the Legend/Layer List button in the Toolbar to toggle between Layers and the Legend. The Legend displays what color is used to display each crime type.



6. To get more detail on particular crimes, make one crime active in the right Legend/Layer frame. The right column selects the active layer. If Residential Burglary is selected as the active layer the Map Window will display detailed information on those individual crimes.


7. Click on the Select by Rectangle button in the Toolbar. 

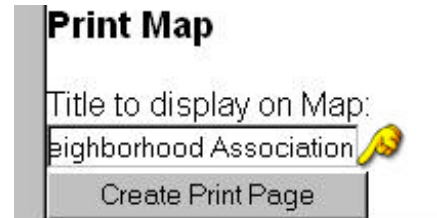
Hold the left mouse button down while dragging a rectangle around any dots on the map representing the crime that is the active layer. The bottom frame now displays details on the selected crimes.

6. To print a map:
















Click on the printer icon in the left toolbar. 
 Type in the title of the map and click on the Create Print Page button
 This will create a new window with a print preview of the map.
 Click the print icon in the browser to print the map.



7. The exit icon returns to the Tulsa Police Department Web Site.

Toolbar Guide

To use a tool, click on the tool, then click on the map display.

-  **Legend/Layer List** – Selects between the legend and layer list.
-  **Overview Map** – Turns the overview map off and on.
-  **Zoom In tool** – Lets you zoom in on the location you click or the box you define on the map.
-  **Zoom Out tool** – Lets you zoom out from the position you click or the area you define on the map.
-  **Full Extent** – Lets you go back to the initial map extent you saw when you first accessed the map.
-  **Previous map button** – Lets you return to the previous extent you were viewing.
-  **Pan tool** – Lets you pan the map display by dragging it.
-  **Measure Tool** –Click once on the map. Move the mouse and the distance is recorded in the box.
-  **Select by Rectangle** – Lets you select object with a rectangle from the active layer and display them in a table form at the bottom of the screen. Also useful for displaying only those crimes you want to by selecting them and then removing the check mark from the visible box on the layer list. ***You must leave the Active button marked or the points you highlighted on the map will disappear.***
-  **Select by Line/Polygon** – Same output as Select by Rectangle. Allows you to be more specific on which objects (crimes) you select.
-  **Clear Selection** – Use to return the map to normal after using Query, Search, Select by Rectangle, Select by Line/Polygon and locate address.
-  **Locate Address** – Use to locate an address or intersection. If an exact match is not found a list will appear with a number next to each address in the list. Click on the Number next to the appropriate address and it will display the address on the map.
-  **Print button** – Lets you print out the map or save it to disk. Opens a separate browser window and displays a page with the current map display, a title, and the legend. Choosing Print from the browser's File menu can print this map. Alternatively, clicking with the right mouse button on either the legend or the map displays a menu so that image can be saved to disk in GIF format.
-  **Exit** Return to Tulsa Police Crime Mapping Introduction page.
-  **Quick Start Guide** --This document
