Homicide Detectives have arrested two suspects for the senseless murders of 21-year-old Ethan Nichols and 19-year-old Carissa Horton, while they walked through Hicks Park Monday night.

Detectives worked diligently gathering information, mounds of evidence, and executing search warrants which in turn, led to the quick apprehension of both suspects, thanks to MVD field officers.

Darren Price (left) and Jerard Davis (right) have both confessed, but while they point the finger at each other as the shooter, they are both charged with two counts of First Degree Murder and two counts of Robbery, under the Felony Murder Rule.
